Motor Service Efficiency Workshop

Join us for an informative collaborative workshop

When a motor fails, the user or owner faces three choices: to rewind to a lower efficiency; to rewind and maintain the original efficiency; or to replace it with a new motor. BPA participates in the Green Motors program to support rewinding motors to preserve their original efficiency.

The collaborative workshops are designed for motor service centers and electric utility staff to learn about products and services available. BPA is hosting a number of these workshops in conjunction with the upcoming summer and fall 2015 regional utility roundtables.

Attendees will learn:

- How motor shops deliver energy efficient products and information to their customers
- How products like VFDs, soft starters, pump coatings, and NEMA Premium motors help customers achieve greater efficiency
- About energy efficiency services offered by green motor rewind shops like energy measurement and verification and motor driven system optimization
- And tour a motor rewind shop to see how they achieve efficiency through green motor rewinds
